Animals around the world.

Subject	Children will learn about;
English	The children will be reading and retelling the story - "Thunder down under." We will also be continuing our Read, Write, Inc journey. We will continue to work on our sentence writing and letter formation.
Maths	The children will begin their learning about fractions. They will learn about equal parts and how many parts make a whole. We will also be learning about multiplication and division, beginning with counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
Science	The Kapow unit we will be following is called "Comparing animals." We will be sorting animals according to physical features. We will also be classifying animals into mammals, reptiles, birds, amphibians and fish.
Computing	The children will be building on their computing skills from the autumn term and learning about digital writing.
Design & Technology/Art	We will be learning about different ways to join fabrics in DT. We will be using this knowledge to create hand puppets. In Art we will further explore textiles and we will be weaving to create art work.
RE/ PSHE	In RE the children will be exploring the question, "What are sacred texts and why do they matter?" In Jigsaw, we will be exploring relationships. This will link to our school value of kindness and the British value of rule of law.
History/Geography	In history we will be learning about Sir David Attenborough and how he has contributed to our knowledge about animals all over the planet. In Geography we will be learning about continents and which animals live there. We will also be comparing Australia to European countries.
PE	We will be recapping our dance learning from the autumn term. We will be sequencing movements and moving to different kinds of music.
