THINGS YOU CAN DO AT HOME:
1. USE PARENTAL CONTROLS ON APPS AND DEVICES
2. TEACH YOUR CHILD HOW TO BLOCK AND REPORT. EVEN GAMES CONSOLES AND TV'S.
3. SET SOME RULES AND BOUNDARIES AROUND THE ONLINE AND HOW TO DEAL WITH THESE. TALK ABOUT THE ISSUES THEY MAY ENCOUNTER. USE OF TECHNOLOGY SUCH AS NO TECH IN BEDROOMS, SCREEN TIME LIMITS AND AGE APPROPRIATE APPS AND GAMES.
